Bring Photo ID for head of household and ID for each member of household. Must be eligible for a normal food pantry. Clients who receive a Thanksgiving pantry from another location will not be served a Thanksgiving pantry.

2020 reservations accepted Thursday, November 5 and closes when program is full or 12 noon on Friday November 20. Must speak with someone to make a reservation; no voice messages will be accepted.

Applicant must be home to receive the meal, no meals will be left at the door. Volunteers prepare and deliver the meals following local regulations and CDC guidelines. Specific delivery times cannot be scheduled. Cannot feed families.
