

Omaha Public Schools – Human Growth and Development Opt In Form Elementary School – Grade 6

In 2016 the Board of Education of the Omaha Public Schools District approved updated curriculum standards for Human Growth and Development for grades 4th – 8th and 10th. This permission form is used to inform and gain signed opt in/opt out of parents/guardian of the elementary curriculum (4th – 5th grade and/or 6th grade) which is taught by the school nurse. Boys and girls will be in separate classes for instruction. **Please note:** parents/guardians may opt out of certain lessons and are asked to indicate on the permission portion below.
